

Report : Inauguration of the Anvishika Resource Centre

The **Anvishika Resource Centre** was inaugurated at **Bal Bharti School, Noida, on Wednesday, 16 April 2025**. An initiative of the Indian Association of Physics Teachers (IAPT), these centres aim to promote hands-on, experiment-based physics education across India.

The ceremony was graced by **Padma Shri awardee Prof. H.C. Verma from IIT Kanpur**, who attended as the Chief Guest. In his address, Prof. Verma emphasised the need to overcome the fear of physics among students by encouraging experiential learning through simple experiments using easily available materials. He also spoke about the National Anvishika Experimental Skill Test (NAEST), conducted by IAPT, urging students to actively participate.

Prof. Verma concluded by stressing the importance of nurturing curiosity and making physics relatable through real-life applications and inquiry-based learning. The event emphasised the role of experiential learning in making physics more engaging and enjoyable for students.
